Systems may only act when temporal readiness, risk assessment, and contextual alignment converge. Premature action is prohibited regardless of capability.

Memory Integrity

Memory must preserve human meaning and narrative continuity. Systems may not optimize away context that humans consider significant.

6

Accountability Walls

Every consequential action must have an identifiable responsible human and auditable system-of-record. Anonymous or diffuse responsibility is prohibited.

Cultural Intelligence

AI must understand cultural nuance, social signals, and ethical norms - or defer to humans. Systems may not act in culturally consequential contexts without cultural competence.

Invariant Enforcement Mechanisms

Each invariant is enforced through multiple complementary mechanisms:

- **Architectural Constraints:** Structural separation prevents violation by design
- **Runtime Validation:** Continuous monitoring detects deviation in real-time
- **VELKOR Safety Barriers:** Dormant safety systems activate upon invariant stress
- **Audit Trails:** Immutable logging enables forensic reconstruction
- **Human Override:** Ultimate human authority can intervene at any point

Identity Anchor Node (IAN)
