ABSTRACT

The Praxis Engine completes the TRINITY architecture by translating Genesis meaning and Genthos reasoning into constitutionally compliant action. Unlike conventional execution layers that simply follow instructions, Praxis implements a comprehensive safety architecture that validates every action against Δ SUM invariants, ensures reversibility where possible, maintains human oversight capabilities, and creates complete audit trails. This paper details the execution pipeline, the safety validation framework, the human escalation protocols, and the feedback mechanisms that enable continuous constitutional improvement. Praxis answers the critical question: How do we act responsibly in the world?

SECTION 1

The Execution Problem

1.1 Action Without Accountability

6. Verification & Feedback

Outcomes are verified against expectations. Feedback is sent to Genthos for learning. Anomalies trigger human review.
